1. You can resist the Word and yet have <u>keen</u> <u>interest</u> in it.

(Jer. 37:7-8, Jer. 37:17, Jer. 38:14, 38:15, Mark 6:20, Acts 24:25)

2. You can resist the Word though you have <u>reason</u> to <u>believe</u> it.

(Jer. 37:19, John 10:24-26a)

- 3. You can resist the Word by submitting to <u>fear.</u> (Jer. 38:5, Jer. 38:17-18, v19, John 12:42-43, Luke 12:4-5)
- 4. Though many resist the Word, there will be a <u>faithful</u> <u>remnant</u>.

(Jer. 38:6, 38:10, 39:15-18)
