A typical Sunday morning for First Kids is built on a Bible lesson that teaches your child about the gospel. Depending on their age group, kids can participate in art, games, music, drama, and small group activities. They will worship God through singing, Scripture reading, and devotional times. On Wednesday evenings during the school year, we focus on choir and missions. In Choir, we teach your child what it means to worship God through music. In Missions, we focus on the importance of serving God by helping others and sharing Jesus. Throughout the year we learn about real life missionaries and provide opportunities for your family to participate in mission projects.
